Driving Directions

*Find your way to Highway 101, and head towards Garberville, CA 95542.

*Take the Garberville Exit from Hwy 101.

*If coming from the South, fill up with fuel prior to leaving town, then head North towards Redway.

*If coming from the North, fill up your fuel in Garberville, and then head North towards Redway.

*After a couple hundred yards, turn onto Alderpoint Rd (your first right) toward Alderpoint/Harris. There is a Blue Heartwood hwy sign at the turn.

*Travel roughly 8 miles. Bear right at the fork towards Harris onto Bell Springs Rd (take the high road).

*Travel roughly 8 more miles on Bell Springs Rd. You will pass the Harris General Store on your right.

Keeping driving, and you will go over cattle guard with the “Drewry Ranch” sign. As you drive safely winding up the next hill, you will arrive at a fork in the road.

*Turn left onto a dirt/gravel road at the fork immediately onto Island Mountain Rd. It goes slightly to the left and uphill.

NOTE: This is the turn that can be tricky for folks. If you see the following, you have gone too far! – Gravel pit on your right, OR an old Crane (we lovingly refer to it as “the Dinosaur”) on your right. If you see these, turn around.

*Travel 4 more miles on dirt road (Island Mountain Road). If daytime, you will see the PVVFD Fire & Rescue station downhill on the right side, then about a half mile down the road, there is a pond on your left. Keep going! After a steep downhill section, you will see a concrete slab with the shape of a heart and the word “wood”.

*Turn left here onto Lauffer Rd. Within 1 min you will see the Heartwood parking lot on your right.

*You have arrived!

-There is very little cell service, once on Island Mountain Road.

-Please note that this drive will take an hour, as it is a mountain road with tight twists and turns and single lane only in some spots.

-Please use pullouts and allow local traffic to pass.

-We suggest that you head up with at least one hour before sunset.
